Baptism/Bautismos

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Many Blessings to all as we begin our Journey of Lent, a very important and meaningful time in the life of the Church. It is a time to look within ourselves and listen to where God is leading us. Lent is meant to be a time to **RESIST** sin, to **REPENT** and to **RETURN** to the Lord. That's not a feeling of shame but an awareness that sin separates us from God and to believe what Christ endured for us, that is, to save us from sin, death, and darkness.

Lent is an ideal time for us to draw closer to God. When John the Baptist conducted his preaching ministry in the desert he cried out, "Repent!" (Mt 3:1), and when Jesus began to preach in Galilee he said exactly the same thing, "Repent!" (Mk 1:15). To repent is to turn away from sin and self-centeredness and to turn to God, and prayer is one of the best ways to turn to God! If you have never prayed very seriously, or if your prayer life has fallen on hard times, Lent is a wonderful occasion to start or restart a warm, communicative relationship with God.

"Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning." This verse from the Book of Joel (Jl 2:12) is part of the Mass readings on Ash Wednesday, followed by further prophetic exhortations to repentance: **"Rend your hearts and not your clothing. Return to the Lord, your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, and relents from punishing."** It is an age-old reminder that Lent is a time of penance, that we are sinners in need of repentance and God's mercy. We are called to mourn, to fast, to turn with sincere sorrow from our failures to follow God's call, with both outward signs and inward conviction.

All of us, as repentant sinners seek cleansing from sin. True repentance leads us to a total change of heart and requires true brokenness, but repentance starts with a true acknowledgment of our sin with a commitment to change. That is why we should not think of Lent as our New Year's resolutions. This time of fasting should not add religious encouragement to a difficult goal: to lose weight, stop watching pornography, give money to charity, or do our daily exercise. Lent is an opportunity to contemplate what our Lord really did for us on the Cross, and so grow in spiritual discipline.

Resolutions simply focus on the "self," not Christ. Lent is an excellent time to give up one's own resolutions and listen for where God is leading me. God's lead might be more difficult than any fast, and Christians realize that they cannot do anything in their own strength either: **only the Grace of God is sufficient** (2 Corinthians 12:9).

Lent is a perfect time of the year to evaluate our own faith life and to consider various ways to improve it. Pope Benedict XVI, during his final message for Lent in 2013, gave his thoughts on what is the key to a fruitful Lent. **"The celebration of Lent ... offers us a valuable opportunity to meditate on the relationship between faith and charity: between believing in God - the God of Jesus Christ - and love, which is the fruit of the Holy Spirit and which guides us on the path of devotion to God and others."** He then explains how faith leads to charity, which is a response to God's love for us. **"The entire Christian life is a response to God's love. The first response is precisely faith as the acceptance, filled with wonder and gratitude, of the unprecedented divine initiative that precedes us and summons us. And the "yes" of faith marks the beginning of a radiant story of friendship with the Lord, which fills and gives full meaning to our whole life. But it is not enough for God that we simply accept his gratuitous love. Not only does he love us, but he wants to draw us to himself, to transform us in such a profound way as to bring us to say with Saint Paul: 'it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me' - Gal 2:20."**

Liturgy

The Feast of the Chair of St. Peter

Contrary to how it may sound, this feast day is not celebrating a piece of furniture. On this feast day, the universal Church acknowledges that St. Peter was the first pope and that his mission continues through the Holy Father today. Simply stated, that mission is to care for the people of God; to carry on the customs, rituals, teachings and truths of Jesus; and to uphold the unity of His Church. Moreover, the Church proclaims that the authority given to St. Peter by Our Lord has been handed down to Peter's successors for the past 2,000 years.



This day is not just about apostolic succession in respect to the pope and the bishops. Among the laity, it symbolizes an unspoken confidence that the Church of Jesus does not change from age to age; that the truths of the Gospel still form the basis of our faith; that these eternal truths are reflected in every Catholic parish and in every Mass. It is a confidence that the leader of our Church adheres to and will never deny the precepts and principles of the Church of Jesus. We firmly believe that we are part of the mystical body of Christ, a holy people, a holy priesthood.
