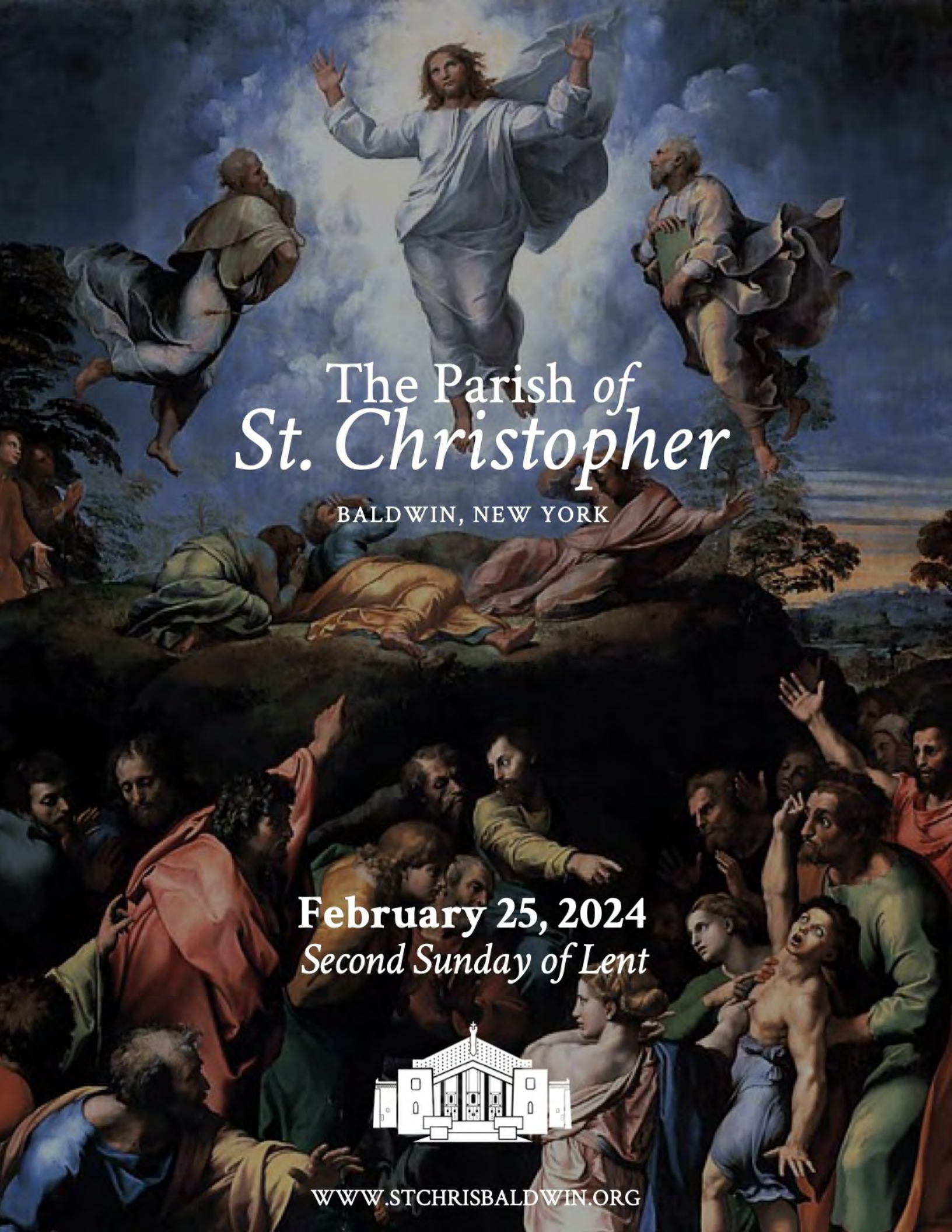

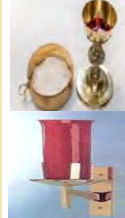
Prayer for Our Troops

Baptism/Bautismos

Pre-registration is required two months before Baptism for the preparation class and the actual date of Baptism. Pastor's Page

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I hope and pray that all are having a Blessed Lent. Let us make every effort, to set aside some time in our schedules to PRAY. Prayer is an important part of our discipleship journey. It is essential to our everyday spiritual life. It becomes even more important during our Lenten journey, when we are called **to Resist sin, Repent and Return to the Lord**. Prayer leads us in our communication with God. Prayer is one of the three pillars of Lent.

Today I would like to take this time to reflect and share with you on the importance of Prayer. To pray is to grow deeper in a relationship with God. In our common understanding, when we talk about prayer, we talk about, 'asking God for something'. Asking for help is a healthy way of acknowledging our dependence on God. We really depend on God, for everything. We read many times throughout the Gospel that Jesus deliberately took time to go off and pray to the Father. That's what Jesus did in his experiences leading up to the Passion. When he desired to speak to God, Jesus often went by himself to be with the Father. It is almost as if he needs that connection as a way of nurturing himself spiritually.

When Jesus went into the Garden of Gethsemane to pray just before his arrest, he asked his disciples to pray as well. The Disciples fell asleep instead of praying. Too often, Christians do that instead of focusing on God. Lent is a time to try to pay more attention to prayer, we need to wake up.

Prayer is communication with God. When we pray, God talks to us, and we talk to God. We listen to God, and God listens to us. Prayer connects us with God. When it comes to prayer, sometimes we do the talking, instead of listening. Very often, it's the silence that gets you to think more about what you're asking God for, and you begin to think about it in different ways.

If we have problems, God is available through prayer. If we are in a difficult situation, prayer brings us comfort and relief. The difficult situation may not change, but our ability to address the situation can change. Even when we may feel that our prayer time is dry and nothing happening or God is silent, God does answer prayer. You may not get the answer you wanted, but that's OK because God just answered it in a better way. You need to be open to God's answer, not just your answer. Prayer makes God available to us. Prayer brings a sense of peace in our lives in the midst of turmoil. Prayer nourishes our relationship with Jesus.

There are different ways and kinds of prayer: vocal prayer, scriptural prayer, meditation, contemplation, liturgical prayer... Vocal prayer involves using a set prayer, such as the Our Father, while scriptural prayer refers to slowly reading a passage of Scripture and opening oneself to God's words. Meditation is a method of prayer that leads us to think and reflect about the different aspects of our journey with God and contemplation involves eliminating outside thoughts and simply being in the presence of God. Participating with other believers in the sacramental life of the Church - the Mass - is liturgical prayer.

The place where we pray is an essential aspect to grow in our prayer life, where prayer comes easily and can be best. Sometimes the best place for you to pray could be a garden on a nice day; sometimes the adoration chapel or sometimes in the silence of your room; where you are able to connect and communicate with God.

One of the challenges to Prayer life, I have to honestly admit, is finding time to pray, and this can be difficult. Therefore, scheduling time for prayer is very important, even when you are busy, you can put aside a few minutes, you can still talk to God and make your life a prayer.

St. John Marie Vianney, the Cure of Ars said: *"We shall never return to God, if we do not have recourse to prayer. Yes, my dear children, with a prayer well said, we can command Heaven and earth, and all will obey us."*

During this holy season of Lent let prayer become an essential part of each of our lives, and may continue after we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. God bless you all.

Liturgy

Saint Gregory of Narek, Doctor of the Church

Gregor was born in a village on the shores of Lake Van between 945 and 950. When his parents died, Gregor and his older brother were raised by a scholarly uncle who had them educated at the Narek monastery where he was a monk. The monastery was a prominent center of learning located in what is now Turkey. Gregor too entered the monastery and was ordained in 977.



A professor of theology, Gregor wrote a mystical interpretation of the Song of Songs, and a long mystical poem called the Book of Prayer or the Book of Lamentations. He described his poem as “an encyclopedia of prayer for all nations.” This classic of Armenian literature has been translated into 30 languages. The Russian text of the Book of Lamentations was set to music in 1985.

Little else is known about Gregor, other than he died in the early 11th century and was buried within the walls of the Narek monastery where he had spent his life. In 2015 as the world observed the 100th anniversary of the Armenian genocide in the Ottoman Empire, Pope Francis concelebrated a Mass at the Vatican with Patriarch Nerses Bedros XIX Tarmouni and declared the monk, poet, and saint of the Armenian Apostolic Church, Gregory of Narek, a Doctor of the Church. His liturgical feast is celebrated on February 27.

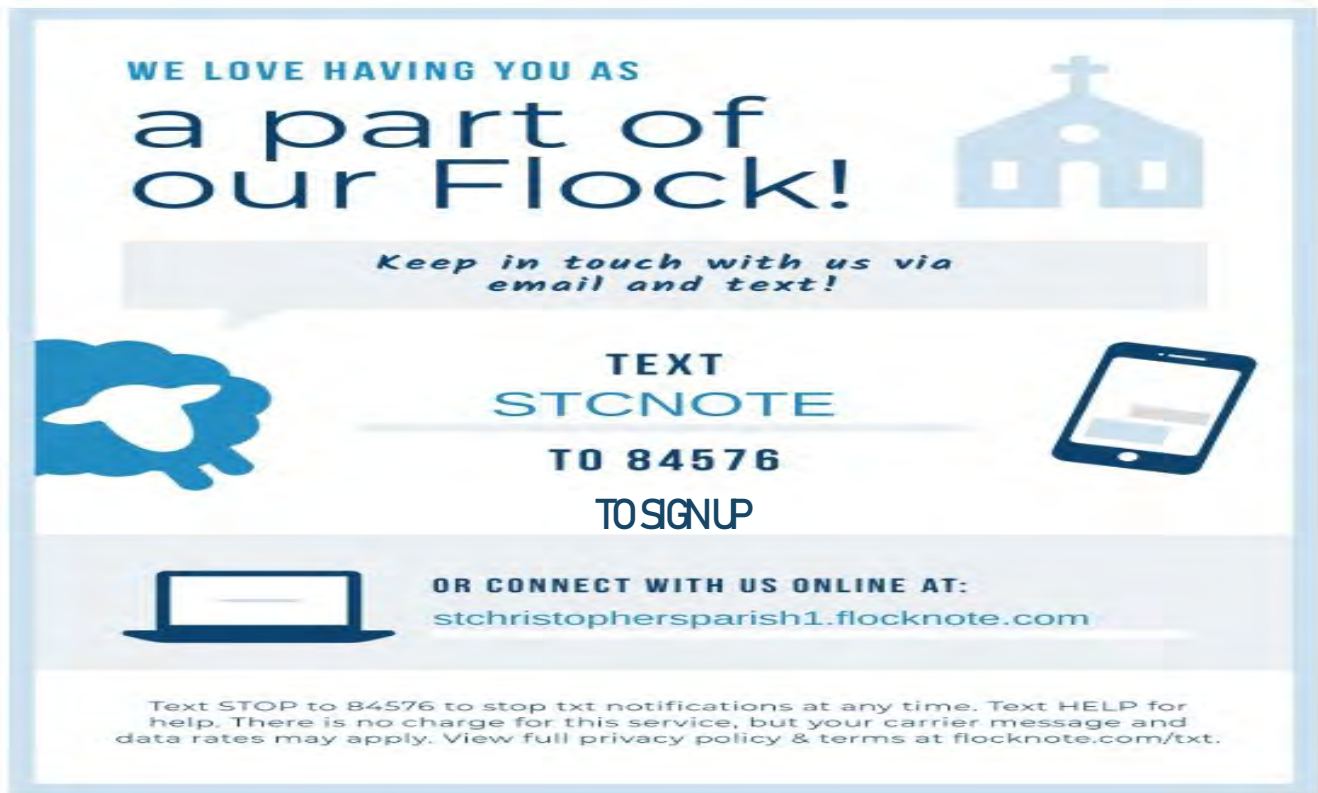
