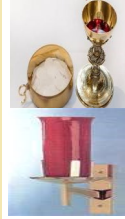

Baptism/Bautismos

My dear Parishioners and Friends,

What an honor and blessing for our community, this weekend, to host the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima, which was entrusted to the World Apostolate of Fatima in 1947 to travel around the world. The statue will be touring the Diocese of Rockville Centre for two weeks, to different parishes, with Masses, confession, talks on Fatima, Holy Hours of Adoration, rosaries and private veneration. The goals are to allow Our Lady of Fatima to claim her dominion over the world through her Immaculate Heart, and to bring the urgent Message of Fatima—the Peace Plan from Heaven—to a world in need. It also encourages devotion through personal consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, which was the mission given to Lucia by the Blessed Mother at Fatima.

Brothers and Sisters, everyone cannot get to Fatima in Portugal, so here is our opportunity, - come experience the graces and blessings of Fatima as Our Lady of Fatima comes to us. She has been traveling the world since 1947. She does this through the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue which has visited almost every country in the world. She brings a message - **Pray for the conversion of sinners, offer sacrifices & penance and Pray for Peace.**

The visitation of the Pilgrim statue of Fatima is a spiritually powerful event for the faithful and is the most effective means to spread this urgent message anew. The hearts She touches along the way cannot be measured. We welcome all here at our Parish this weekend to reflect on the message she brings to us. As we focus our gaze on the Pilgrim Statue of Fatima, let us remember what she said "I promise to assist them at the hour of death, with all graces necessary for the salvation of their souls."

On June 13, 1917, Lucia asked the Blessed Virgin to lead them to Heaven. The Blessed Virgin answered: "Yes, I will lead Jacinta and Francisco there soon. But you, Lucia, will remain here some time longer. **JESUS WANTS TO USE YOU TO MAKE ME KNOWN AND LOVED. HE WANTS TO ESTABLISH IN THE WORLD DEVOTION TO MY IMMACULATE HEART - Through the Five First Saturdays. - I PROMISE SALVATION TO THOSE WHO ADOPT THIS DEVOTION AND THE SOULS WHO PRACTICE IT -The Five First Saturdays- WILL BE BELOVED OF GOD. THEY WILL BE AS FLOWERS PLACED BY ME ADORNING HIS THRONE.**"

Our Lady of Fatima's Peace Plan from Heaven; it is a call for prayer and penance offered in reparation for sin. Our Lady said at Fatima, "War is a punishment for sin." She asks for Communion of Reparation on the First Saturday of the month and that we offer up each act daily as a sacrifice for sin. Pray the Rosary, be consecrated to Her Immaculate Heart, and wear the Brown Scapular as a sign of this consecration.

I'm very excited that the statue is coming to St. Christopher's — it's been my dream to bring her here. Her presence here reminds us that we're never alone. Our Lady is always with us in our suffering and our moments of joy. So, visiting the statue is a chance to renew our faith and find hope for the future. Let us take time to think and pray on the messages of Fatima. How can I grow everyday, in and through the messages of the Blessed Mother?

I invite you to partake in this special visitation of the Blessed Mother and experience all her blessings. Thank you to all, who have shared their time and talent to prepare for this great honor. May God bless you all.

Liturgy

St. Anthony of Padua

The gospel call to leave everything and follow Christ was the rule of Saint Anthony of Padua's life. Over and over again, God called him to something new in his plan. Every time Anthony responded with renewed zeal and self-sacrificing to serve his Lord Jesus more completely. His journey as the servant of God began as a very young man when he decided to join the Augustinians in Lisbon, giving up a future of wealth and power to be a servant of God. Later when the bodies of the first Franciscan martyrs went through the Portuguese city where he was stationed, he was again filled with an intense longing to be one of those closest to Jesus himself: those who die for the Good News.



So Anthony entered the Franciscan Order and set out to preach to the Moors. But an illness prevented him from achieving that goal. He went to Italy and was stationed in a small hermitage where he spent most of his time praying, reading the Scriptures and doing menial tasks. The call of God came again at an ordination where no one was prepared to speak. The humble and obedient Anthony hesitantly accepted the task. The years of searching for Jesus in prayer, of reading sacred Scripture and of serving him in poverty, chastity, and obedience had prepared Anthony to allow the Spirit to use his talents. Anthony's sermon was astounding to those who expected an unprepared speech and knew not the Spirit's power to give people words.

Recognized as a great man of prayer and a great Scripture and theology scholar, Anthony became the first friar to teach theology to the other friars. Soon he was called from that post to preach to the Albigensians in France, using his profound knowledge of Scripture and theology to convert and reassure those who had been misled by their denial of Christ's divinity and of the sacraments.

After he led the friars in northern Italy for three years, he made his headquarters in the city of Padua. He resumed his preaching and began writing sermon notes to help other preachers. In the spring of 1231 Anthony withdrew to a friary at Camposampiero where he had a sort of treehouse built as a hermitage. There he prayed and prepared for death. On June 13, he became very ill and asked to be taken back to Padua, where he died after receiving the last sacraments. Anthony was canonized less than a year later and named a Doctor of the Church in 1946.

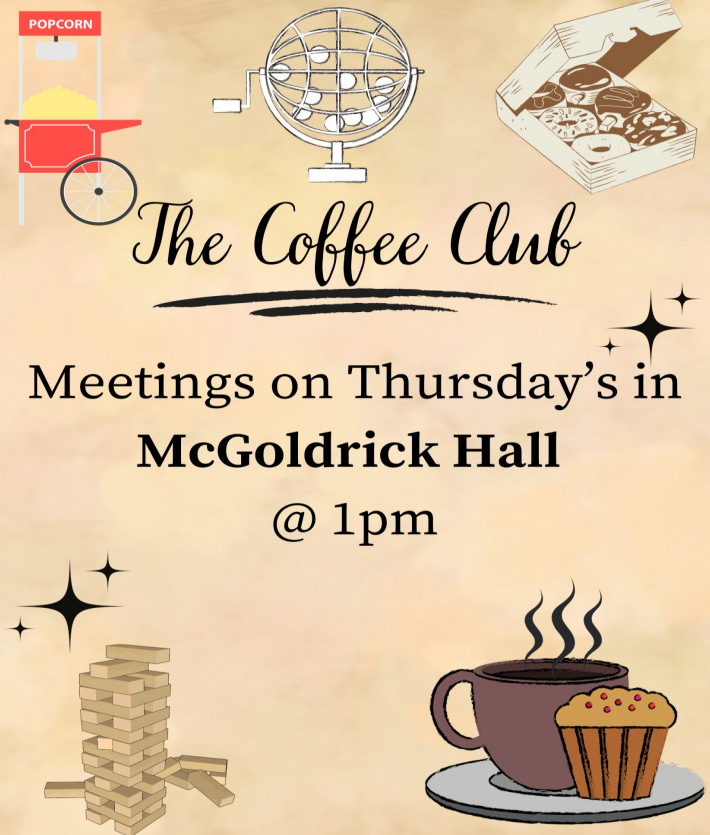
