Baptism/Bautismos

Pre-registration is required two months before Baptism for the preparation class and the actual date of Baptism. The required Baptismal Preparation class is held on the first Sunday of each month at 9:30AM Mass in the Church and class to follow in the Buckley Room in Lawlor Hall. My dear Parishioners and Friends,

As we continue to speak about the Jubilee Year, today let us focus on **Jubilee as a time for reconciliation and mercy**. This dates back to the Jubilees of the Old Testament, when **the Lord commanded the people to free slaves, forgive debts, and return property**.

It is one of the greatest examples of social and communal mercy in the Old Testament. The people were to learn mercy by giving mercy. The Jubilee Year remains a moment of reconciliation and mercy. Rather than being freed from physical bondage or released from monetary debts, **God wants to deliver us from what truly ties us down: *sin and death***. He did so on the Cross, but He calls us to participate in this through the sacraments and acts of mercy and charity. There is a special indulgence given during the Jubilee Year, which Pope Francis says "allows us to discover how limitless God's mercy is."

What is an "Indulgence"? The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains, "An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints." - Paragraph 1471

How do I receive the Jubilee indulgence? The Vatican has announced that this Jubilee indulgence will be given to those pilgrims who, repentant of their sins, make a pilgrimage to any sacred Jubilee site: to at least one of the Major Papal Basilicas of Rome or to the Holy Land. On pilgrimage at these places, the pilgrim should spend time in prayer, at least the Our Father, a Profession of Faith, and a Marian prayer. Each Diocese has its own Holy Doors. There are other places of pilgrimage and other ways to receive the indulgence too. Pilgrims should also receive Holy Communion and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, and be detached from sin. For those who cannot make the Jubilee pilgrimage due to illness or other circumstances are nonetheless invited to take part in the spiritual movement that accompanies the Jubilee year, offering up the sufferings of their daily lives, and participating in the Eucharistic celebration.

Always remember, our sins have effects- *some of these effects may be eternal* - if we die in the state of mortal sin - *and some effects are temporal*. After all, even the "smallest" venial sins change us - they draw us away from God, make us less like Christ - and affect those around us. Even after we go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation and are forgiven our sins and freed from the eternal punishment we deserve, we still have to atone for our sins. We need to be purified of those temporal punishments, the unhealthy attachments and ways we've hurt ourselves, others, and God. This purification can be done in Purgatory, but it can also be done here on earth: by offering up our sufferings and by becoming more like Christ in acts of charity and prayer.

Indulgences are graces given through the Church as she opens "**the treasury of the merits of Christ and the saints.**" The Church encourages us to do works of devotion, penance, and charity. For example, there are indulgences attached to spending time in mental prayer, praying the Stations of the Cross, or, the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Some indulgences are partial - removing part of the temporal punishment due to sin - and some are plenary - removing all of the temporal punishment due to sin. An indulgence can also be applied to a loved one who is in purgatory.

Pope Francis said; "**God is always ready to forgive, and he never tires of forgiving in ways that are continually new and surprising. ... In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, God forgives our sins, which he truly blots out; and yet sin leaves a negative effect on the way we think and act. But the mercy of God is stronger even than this. It becomes indulgence on the part of the Father who, through the Bride of Christ, his Church, reaches the pardoned sinner and frees him from every residue left by the consequences of sin, enabling him to act with charity, to grow in love rather than to fall back into sin.**"

The Jubilee Indulgence is a concrete manifestation of God's mercy, which allows us to free our hearts from the weight of sin because the reparation due for our sins is given freely and abundantly.

May we continue to experience and merit God's mercy as we journey through this Jubilee Year.

Liturgy

St. Scholastica

St. Scholastica, sister of St. Benedict, consecrated her life to God from her earliest youth. After her brother went to Monte Cassino, where he established his famous monastery, she took up her abode in the neighborhood at Plombariola, where she founded and governed a monastery of nuns, about five miles from that of St. Benedict, who, it appears, also directed his sister and her nuns. She visited her brother once a year, and as she was not allowed to enter his monastery, he went in company with some of his brethren to meet her at a house some distance away. These visits were spent in conferring together on spiritual matters. On one occasion they had passed the time as usual in prayer and pious conversation and in the evening they sat down to take their reflection. St. Scholastica begged her brother to remain until the next day. St. Benedict refused to spend the night outside his monastery. She had recourse to prayer and a furious thunderstorm burst so that neither St. Benedict nor any of his companions could return home. They spent the night in spiritual conferences. The next morning they parted to meet no more on earth. Three days later St. Scholastica died, and her holy brother beheld her soul in a vision as it ascended into heaven. He sent his brethren to bring her body to his monastery and laid it in the tomb he had prepared for himself. She died about the year 543, and St. Benedict followed her soon after. Her feast day is February 10th.

Featured Saint of the Week



Who is St. Josephine?

- Josephine Bakhita was born in 1869, in a small village in the Darfur region of Sudan.
- Historians believe that sometime in February 1877, Josephine was kidnapped by Arab slave traders. Although she was just a child, she was forced to walk barefoot over 600 miles to a slave market.
- She was treated cruelly by several of the people who bought her and she suffered with heroic patience.
- She was eventually brought to Italy and set free by an Italian court.
- When she was received into the Catholic Church, the Archbishop who gave her the sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation was none other than Giusseppe Sarto, the Cardinal Patriarch of Venice, who would later become St. Pope Pius X.
- Josephine became a religious sister with the Canossian Daughters of Charity religious order. She was eventually assigned to a convent in Schio, Vicenza in northern Italy.
- During World War II, the people of the village of Schio regarded her as their protector. Although bombs fell on their village, not one citizen died.
- On the evening of February 8, 1947, Josephine spoke her last words: "Our Lady, Our Lady!" She then died.
- St. Josephine was canonized on October 1, 2000 by St. Pope John Paul II. She is the first person to be canonized from Sudan and is the patron saint of the country.

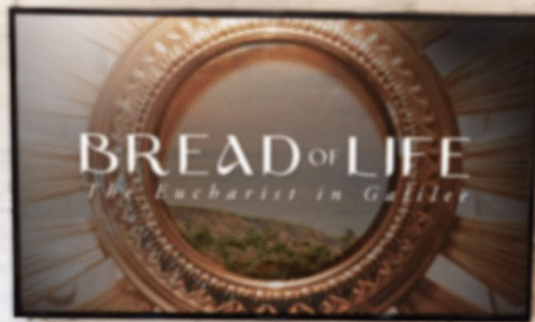
