Baptism/Bautismos

REMEMBERING DEAR FR. ROBERT HOLZ

Brothers and Sisters, as we mourn the loss of Fr. Holz, and pray for the repose of his soul, I would like to quote a short passage from his recent Christmas message:

"God is with us! Can there be more positive or uplifting words? We come to be with Him, as the shepherds did. We come to Him together.

For those times in our lives when we have walked in darkness, we know the great light and rush to Him with "abundant joy!" We acknowledge that He came to be with us, and to stay! We come to church and recognize Him in our worship, and we stay. We gather at His table, rejoicing in His love.

We know this is right. We know this is good. We come together for the many activities in the church. But we especially come together for worship, and for Catholics this means Mass, and we plan to stay, week after week after week, just as Jesus remains with us.

What a wonderful time to invite (or re-invite) someone who may not have stayed. This joyful celebration is good not only for us, but for them as well. We invite them to return to something good, something powerful, something joyful. One day your invitation, or rather your extension of His invitation, will be appreciated, by those who are invited and by those of us here welcoming them back.

We need to be here, with Him. We need to be a people where those who need Him can come and find sanctuary for the difficulties in their lives. We need to be here for them, and for ourselves, one with the God who created us and who loves us still."

Rev. Robert A. Holz after ordination, received his first assignment here at St. Christopher's in Baldwin from 2008 to 2013, he was then named as Pastor of St. Raphael's in East Meadow in June of 2013. Fr. Holz grew up on Long Island and received a bachelor's degree from St. John's University in business. After a career of almost 20 years as an accountant, he entered the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception for priestly formation. He worked as an accountant for nearly two decades. He was basically happy. He was 40 years old. Still, the question was there. "Is God calling me? Or not?". Partly because he felt unfulfilled, and with hopes of resolving that nagging question, he quit his job and inquired about becoming a priest. He was one of nine men ordained in June 2008,

On reflecting on his CALLING, Fr. Holz said "I was doing well; the companies I worked for were generous, so there were regular promotions, regular raises. But by the end, when I was earning this much more than when I started, I would have expected to be this much happier, and I wasn't...Looking for fulfillment is what brought me here."

Last month when I spoke to Fr. Walter, he shared with me about the celebration the Parish hosted, "It was a great honor to celebrate our beloved Pastor Emeritus, Fr. Holz, this past Sunday, March 16th. The Eucharistic celebration was beautiful and a tribute to his life and legacy to our parishes, The Catholic Church on Long Island and beyond. The overwhelming presence of parishioners from St. Philip Neri, Our Lady Queen of Martyrs, St. Raphael's in East Meadow, St. Christopher's in Baldwin, St. Francis de Chantal in Wantagh and beyond testifies to Fr. Holz's selfless ministry infused with his Eucharistic Heart and love of Jesus. It bespeaks the many lives he touched and the many lives that touched him throughout his ministry. Amid our mixed emotions, Fr. Holz gave us many reasons to laugh with him during his homily. Also, he shared very profound words of hope that will forever stay close to our hearts: 'God will never give you more than you and He can handle. So, you stick with Him, and you can get through anything'."

May I ask you to pray a rosary, or a chaplet of Divine Mercy for the repose of the soul of Fr. Robert Holz or to participate in a memorial Mass. Let our prayers for him be a part of his great journey into the heart of all Love. The funeral arrangements are as follows:
