My dear Parishioners and Friends.

The rosary, has always been a very important part of my prayer life - *my journey with Jesus through Mary*. During the month of October we are called especially to pray, promote and teach others, how to pray the Rosary. The Church celebrates the Feast of "Our Lady of the Rosary" on Oct. 7. The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Dominic in 1206 after he had been praying and doing severe penance because of his lack of success in combating the Albigensian heresy. Mother Mary praised him for his valiant fight against the heretics and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon, explained its uses and efficacy, and told him to preach it to others.

Thanks to Pope Leo the XIII, who dedicated the month of October to the Holy Rosary, an enthusiastic promoter of the rosary. In the span of only five years, Pope Leo XIII, wrote eleven encyclicals on the rosary. St. John Paul II called the rosary his favorite prayer, "in which we meditate with Mary upon the mysteries which she as a Mother meditated on in her heart (Lk. 2:19)."

Pope Benedict XVI in an address at the Basilica of St. Mary Major where he prayed the rosary with the faithful said: "Today, together we confirm that the Holy Rosary is not a pious practice banished to the past, like prayers of other times thought of with nostalgia. Instead, the Rosary is experiencing a new Springtime. Without a doubt, this is one of the most eloquent signs of love that the young generation nourish for Jesus and his Mother, Mary. In the current world, so dispersive, this prayer helps to put Christ at the centre, as the Virgin did, who meditated within all that was said about her Son, and also what he did and said. When reciting the Rosary, the important and meaningful moments of salvation history are relived. The various steps of Christ's mission are traced. With Mary the heart is oriented toward the mystery of Jesus. Christ is put at the centre of our life, of our time, of our city, through the contemplation and meditation of his holy mysteries of joy, light, sorrow and glory. May Mary help us to welcome within ourselves the grace emanating from these mysteries, so that through us we can "water" society, beginning with our daily relationships, and purifying them from so many negative forces, thus opening them to the newness of God. The Rosary, when it is prayed in an authentic way, not mechanical and superficial but profoundly, it brings, in fact, peace and reconciliation. It contains within itself the healing power of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, invoked with faith and love at the centre of each "Hail Mary".

I spoke to some of the faithful who pray the Rosary daily, this is how they shared their experience of praying the rosary; *The rosary is a powerful and important prayer because it deepens our relationship with God by meditating on the life of Jesus Christ through Mary's eyes, provides us spiritual strength to overcome sin and grow in virtue, helps to focus the mind and emotions on positive, divine themes, and it is a spiritual weapon against evil and a path to world peace and personal conversion. The rhythmic, repetitive nature of this prayer also brings a calming, contemplative effect, fostering a connection with God and the Virgin Mary.*

St. Louis de Montfort, in his book "The Secret Power of the Rosary" explores the Rosary's spiritual significance and transformative effects, encouraging devotion to Jesus and Mary through this prayer practice. The book emphasizes that reciting the Rosary, with its meditation on Gospel mysteries, strengthens one's relationship with Christ, following are some key aspects that St. Louis De Montfort describes as the "Power" of the Rosary: **1.Spiritual Foundation:** The Rosary's meditations are rooted in the foundational mysteries of the New Testament, offering a comprehensive journey through Christ's life and love. **2.Connection to God:** The practice of the Rosary helps deepen a personal relationship with God and Mary, fostering a greater love for Jesus and a clearer path to holiness. **3. Victory Over Evil:** The Rosary is described as a powerful weapon against evil, sin, and the devil, with the potential to bring spiritual victory and inner peace. **4. Guidance and Inspiration:** Praying the Rosary can lead to increased openness to the Holy Spirit, greater confidence in God's providence, and inspiration in times of darkness. **5. Miraculous Effects:** The practice is believed to bring about miraculous effects in a person's life, increasing their love for Christ, their hatred for sin, and their ability to overcome temptation. **6. Timeless Resource:** It is considered a timeless and invaluable resource for believers of all experience levels, providing wisdom, inspiration, and practical guidance for a richer prayer life.

May I invite you to please Pray and Reflect on the Rosary and above all be promoters of the Rosary by teaching others how to Pray the Rosary.

Reduce your 2025 Taxes with a Charitable IRA Rollover!

Are you 70 1/2 or older with an IRA? Consider a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) of up to \$108,000 in 2025 to your parish or other ministry. Satisfy your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) and keep more of your hard-earned retirement savings out of your taxable income.

A QCD allows an IRA owner (and an IRA beneficiary) aged 70.5 or older to make charitable donations directly through their IRAs. IRA funds are transferred directly from the IRA to a qualified charitable organization. Most Importantly, the funds withdrawn and transferred from the traditional IRA are not taxable. Normally, when a withdrawal is made from a traditional IRA, the withdrawal is considered a taxable event.

The best way for you to start is with your IRA custodian. Tell them you want to make a "qualified charitable distribution". In most cases you will only have to fill out a simple form.

VERY IMPORTANT!! Your gift must go directly from your IRA to the Charity. If you receive the money first, then you'll be taxed on it like any other distribution

Beyond annual giving, an IRA Charitable Rollover can be a powerful tool for estate planning. Consider naming our organization as a beneficiary of your IRA, leaving a legacy of support that aligns with your values and lessening the tax burden on your heirs.

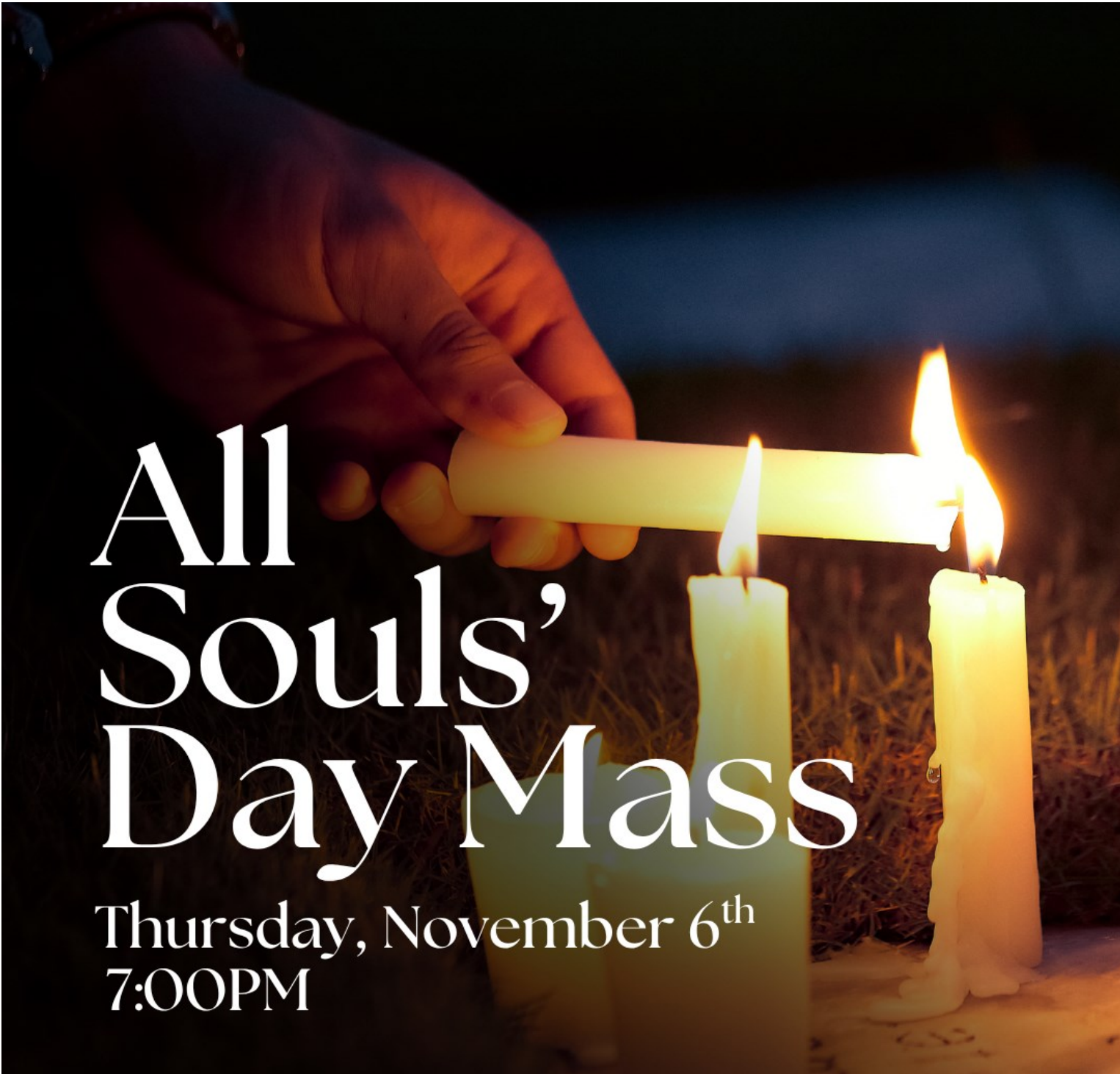
